

"...but when I became a MAN..."

The Word of God gives us a clear understanding of adult maturity, as the apostle Paul describes his own transformation from adolescence, to manhood (Read 1 Corinthians 13:11 KJV-left).

Paul confessed that as a child, he **SPOKE**, he **UNDER-STOOD**, and he **THOUGHT** as a child...in that **ORDER!** All adults know that this <u>natural order</u> of behavior fits all children in adolescence. They **SPEAK** before they posses **UNDERSTANDING**, and will make public their **UNDERSTANDING** before giving clear **THOUGHT** to it.

This is why God declares that "...FOOLISHNESS (silliness; showing a lack of wisdom, good sense, seriousness or irresponsibleness) is **BOUND** in the **HEART** of a (that is, every) child..." (Proverbs 22:15 KJV).

The **HEART** of mankind is the **CENTER** of man that **THINKS**. From there originates his **FEELINGS**, his **WILL**, and his **INTELLECT**. This is **NOT** the muscle that pumps the blood throughout the body, but the **HEAD**.

The surest sign of **MATURITY** is when we begin to become serious (<u>or sober</u>) minded in our daily living. When we first begin to <u>actively</u> prune away our own silliness, we began **THINKING FIRST**, and through wisdom, **INTERPRET** what we have thought, and then, guard our own tongue, <u>before</u> we **SPEAK**.

Paul said, "...but when I became a man, I <u>PUT AWAY</u> childish things." "<u>Put away</u>" means that Paul rendered those <u>former things</u> of his youth entirely <u>useless</u>.

"CHILDISH THINGS" is found in the scriptures only ONCE and it means infantile; simple-minded; and im"When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: But when I became a man, I put away childish things."

mature. Paul is **NOT** referring to "toys" here, but to the foolish thoughts and actions of youth.

Both the tobacco and alcohol industry, and drug dealers target the **IMMATURE** because their <u>stubborn pride</u> causes them to reject the counsel of the wise, making them vulnerable and easily manipulated.

To truly mature, you must humble your-self before God and say: "Lord, make me to know mine end, and the measure of my days, what it is; that I may know how frail I am" (Psalm 39:4).
