There was a certain King, which made a marriage for his Son. He sent forth his Servants to call



them that were invited to the wedding: and they would not come. Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, "*Tell them which are invited, 'Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready:* come unto the marriage." But they made light of it, and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise. And they that were left, took his servants, and entreated them spitefully, and slew them.

But when the King heard this, he became enraged, and sent forth his armies, and destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. Then said he to his servants, "*The wedding is ready, but they which were invited were not worthy. Go therefore into the highways, and as many as you shall find, invite to the marriage.*"

So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, both bad and good, and the wedding was furnished with guests. And when the King came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which did not have on a wedding garment. And he said to him, "*Friend, how is it that you came in here not having on a wedding garment?*" And he was speechless.

Then said the King to the servants, "Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness (the Lake of Fire); there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. For many are called, but few are chosen." (Read Matthew 22:1-14)

These are the last days spoken of by Daniel the Prophet and the Apostle John as the Holy Spirit inspired him to write the book of Revelation.

<u>Many</u> are called, as witnessed by the staggering congregations of Christian movements. Also, there are <u>many</u> who follow movements other than Christ.

But <u>the end</u> of a man's life will tell the <u>true story</u>, which shall come

too late for them. Only the FEW will enter LIFE.

In the last days, God said that "...evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived" (2 Tim. 3:13), but the Word

of Truth also declares: "...I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me" (John 14:6).



At the end of life's journey, many will be standing before God without a wedding garment. Don't be one of them.

No man can come to God except *through* the **DOOR**, which is Christ Jesus. It

doesn't matter what you **THINK**! It does matter what God has **SAID**.

If you <u>refuse</u> to believe it **NOW**, one day, you **WILL** believe, but it will be too late for you.
