

Religion Divided over Gay Marriage

Since the California Supreme Court ruling took place allowing state-sanctioned same-sex marriages, organized religions are again divided over religious doctrine concerning homosexuality.



The nation's religious communities, including <u>Judaism</u>, are drawing lines of division that could mirror the Episcopalian split that took place following the 2003 ordination of New Hampshire's gay man, the <u>Right Reverend V. Gene Robinson</u>. The Episcopa-

lian Diocese of San Joaquin voted to split from the national church.

Yet, none of these organized religions base their disagreements on what **God Himself** has to say, because they no longer believe that **God spoke, and holy men wrote it down**. Their arguments are solely based on their religious teachings and doctrines.



However, in these <u>last days</u>, watch the behavior of the nation <u>Israel</u> and it's continued rebel-

lion towards the word of God, including **Sodomy**.

<u>Conservative</u> Judaism, for example, recently voted to allow gay unions and ordain gay rabbis. <u>Reform</u> Judaism has been officiating at same-sex ceremonies for nearly two decades. Israel has even allowed Gay Parades in the city of <u>Jerusalem</u>, the city which God chose to <u>put His name there</u> (Read 1 Kings 9:3).

God Spoke, Man Wrote, No One Believes

The word of God is plain on the subject of <u>Sodomy</u>. God said to the Israeli male, "Thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with womankind: it is abomination" (Leviticus 18:22).

But Israel rebelled against God.

Today, because religion has "...changed the truth of God into a lie..." and are worshipping and serving the creature (such as preachers, priests, rabbis, etc.) more

than the <u>Creator</u> (Romans 1:25), most <u>women</u> have changed their <u>natural use</u>, going after animals and each other.
