n the days of Jesus, he healed the sick and raised the dead. He opened the eyes of the blind. He straighten withered hands and caused the lame to walk, the deaf to hear and the dumb to talk. He even cast out devils, bringing sanity back to the minds of those who had lost it.

The man responded to Jesus and said, "...Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me" (John 5:7).

When you and I come to realize our own "helplessness" and acknowledge that there is "...no man..., including our selves, that can solve our "helplessness," then God comes to "seek" and to "save" through the GOSPEL of His Word: "...I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first (to Israel), and also to the *Greek* (or Gentiles, meaning, 'us')" (Romans 1:16).

Jesus replied to the man, "... Rise, take up thy bed, and walk" (John 5:8). "And **IMMEDIATELY** the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked" (John 5:9).

No, God doesn't heal on the "installment plan" or in increments. God is **INSTAN-TANEOUS!**

God said that "If we confess our sins. **HE** is faithful and just to **forgive us our** sins, and to cleanse us from ALL unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9).

God, who promised eternal life before the world began, cannot lie. Read these words: "In HOPE of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, PROMISED before the world began" (Titus 1:2).
