Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee" (Genesis 13:14-17).</u>

Although Abraham has not fully received this land yet, "...Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness" (Romans 4:3). "For the promise, that he should be the heir of THE WORLD, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of FAITH" (Romans 4:13).

In October of 2005, the President of Iran Mahmoud Ahmadinejad not only made the threat that Israel must be wiped off the map, but he also said, "Anybody who recognizes Israel will burn in the fire of the Islamic nations fury."
