



Do You have on a Wedding Garment?

There was a certain King, which made a marriage for his Son. He sent forth his Servants to call them that were invited (*the Jews*) to the wedding: and they would not come. Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, "*Tell them which are invited, 'Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: **COME unto the marriage.**'*" But they made light of it, and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise. And they that were left, took his servants, and entreated them spitefully, and slew them.

But when the King heard this, he became enraged, and sent forth his armies, and destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. Then said he to his servants, "*The wedding is ready, but they which were invited were not worthy. Go therefore into the highways, and as many as you shall find (the Gentiles), invite to the marriage.*"

So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, both bad and good, and the wedding was furnished with guests. And when the King came in to see the guests, he saw there *a man which did not have on a wedding garment*. And he said to him, "*Friend, how is it that you came in here not having on a wedding garment?*" And he was speechless. Then said the King to the servants, "*Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness (the Lake of Fire): there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.*" (Read Matthew 22:1-14).

If **you** have on a "**Wedding Garment**," it means that you are a "**True Christian**." It means that you were once persuaded that you are a *perpetual* sinner.

It means that you asked God, just like the sinful Publican in Luke 18:13, "*...standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, **God be merciful to me a sinner.***"

Have you done that? Are you **SURE** you are born of the Spirit of God, or did Satan slip you a **counterfeit** with all the trimmings of religion?

God instructs **ALL** believers to "*...give diligence to make your calling and election **sure***" (2 Peter 1:10). How **do** we do that? God said, "***Examine yourselves, whether ye be IN the faith: prove***

your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates" (2 Cor. 13:5)?

Is Jesus Christ **IN** you? Do you know it? Remember, '***if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his***' (Romans 8:9).

Religion has many **garments** to choose from, but there is only **ONE** "**Wedding Garment**:" '***I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me***' (John 14:6).

So the question for you is, "Are **YOU** ready for the "**Marriage Supper**" with the "**Bridegroom**," do you have your "**Wedding Garment**" on before Christ appears? The wedding is prepared and ready. You are invited: **Come!**
