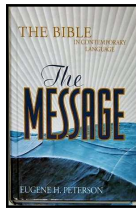


The Spirit of Truth is ALREADY Come

Various study bibles are purchased as guides to clarify scripture, while bible translations are written to make the Bible easier to understand. They are slowly substituting the Word of God.

Is this what God meant for the believer to do when He said "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that need not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15)?

True believers learn, not in the words which man's wisdom teaches, "...but which the Holy Ghost teaches; comparing spiritual things with spiritual" (1 Cor. 2:13). The Holy Ghost is the teacher that permanently abides in every believer, to lead and guide the believer in ALL truth.

If you are not able to understand the Word of God without the help of someone else, then you are not born again. All believers are SEALED by the Holy Spirit the moment they are born again "...unto the day of redemption" (Ephes. 4:30).

We are living in the "times" that God's

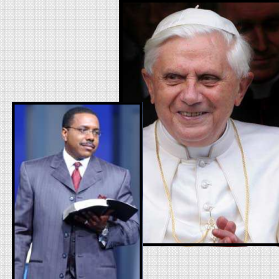

The “Famine” of the Word of God: “Behold, the days come, saith the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord; and they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the Lord, and shall not find it” (Amos 8:11-12).

Teaching Doctrines of Fables: “For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables” (2 Tim. 4:3-4).

The Character-Change in Man: “This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, Without natural affection, truce-breakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, Traitors, heady, high-minded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God.

The next great event to take place upon this earth is the translation of all believers to meet our Lord in the air, and the Holy Ghost will leave with us. In Matthew 25:1,

begins an interesting parable about “...ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom (**Christ**). Five of them were wise, and five were foolish. They that were foolish took their lamps, and took **NO OIL** (**Holy Spirit**) with them: But the wise **TOOK OIL** in their vessels with their lamps. While the bridegroom tarried (**During this Church Age**), they **ALL** slumbered and slept. And at midnight (**In these Last Days**) there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him. Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and **BUY** for yourselves. And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and **they that were READY** went in with him to the marriage: **and the door was shut** (**Just like Noah's Ark**). Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, **Lord, Lord**, open to us. But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, **I know you not**.

WATCH therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh” (Matthew 25:1-13).

Are you **READY**? “**BUY the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding**” (Proverbs 23:23).
