ne of the greatest questions ever asked was by a jailer overhearing Paul and Silas praying in the prison: "<u>Sirs, what must I do</u> <u>to be saved</u>" (Acts 16:30)? This jailer had heard the gospel through these holy men that persuaded him to inquire about saving his soul.

The TRUTH about S

Even one of the thieves during his own crucifixion heard enough to ask Jesus, "Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, **TODAY** shalt thou be with me in paradise (Luke 23:42-43).

Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God is the only name that brings salvation: "<u>Neither is there salvation in</u> <u>any other: for there is none other name under</u> <u>heaven given among men, whereby we must be</u> <u>saved</u>" (Acts 4:12).

Before anyone can be saved, he or she **MUST** believe that God exists by faith: "<u>But without faith</u> <u>it is impossible to please</u> [God]: <u>for he that</u> <u>cometh to God MUST believe that</u> [God] <u>is, and</u> <u>that</u> [God] <u>is a rewarder of them that diligently</u> <u>seek him</u>" (Hebrews 11:6).

There is only one way to erase your sins before you die, "...*except ye repent, ye shall...perish*"

(Luke 13:3). When you repent to God, humble yourself before Him as a little child would before his or her parents.





Jesus said "...<u>Except ye be converted, and be-</u> come as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:3-4).

When the Jews heard Peter preach, they asked 'What shall we do?' Peter replied, "...<u>Repent, and</u> be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
