They married with few possessions. Their wedding was small and humble with few guests, and their reception even smaller, but they loved each other fervently.


Together, they continued to trust God with their lives and decisions. Because of their faithfulness, God blessed them with much fruit from the womb. And they loved and cherished every child.

But when the children grew, they left their nest with new-found freedom and went their ways. They joined with the world, a world contrary to their upbringing, and they embraced it fully.

"And when the [children] saw that the [world pleasures] was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a [world] to be desired to make one wise, [they] took of the fruit [of disobedience] thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto [their brothers and sisters] with [them]; and [they all] did eat" (Genesis 3:6).

Wherefore their parents, seeing they departed from "<u>the way</u>," called out to them using the Word of God as a reminder, saying,

"...come out from among [the world], and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, and will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty" (2 Cor. 6:17-18).

But their children would not come. However, the parents, remembering the promise that God made to them, comforted their hearts:

"Train up a CHILD in the way he should go: and WHEN HE IS OLD, HE WILL NOT DEPART FROM IT" (Proverbs 22:6).



Therefore, the parents had comfort in the remembrance of those words, knowing that God will keep His promise to them. They earnestly pray together for their children, and the families of their children.

What about you? Have you heard the Wonderful Words of Eternal Life in your lifetime, and ignored it? Have you prepared your children with the word of God?

<u>What?</u> You don't believe that God exists; or believe that Jesus rose from the dead; or that God spoke, and holy men wrote it down? <u>Listen</u>...

No man on the face of the earth, <u>past, present</u> <u>or future</u>, can <u>PROVE</u> that this <u>did not</u> happen. Neither can any man <u>PROVE</u> that it <u>did</u> happen. This is <u>WHY</u> God said:

"But without <u>FAITH</u> it is <u>IMPOSSIBLE</u> to please <u>GOD</u>: for he that cometh to God <u>MUST</u> believe that he <u>IS</u>, and that he is a <u>REWARDER</u> of them that <u>DILIGENTLY</u> seek him" (Hebrews 11:6).

<u>Today</u> is the <u>DAY</u> of salvation. <u>NOW</u> is the accepted time (2 Cor. 6:2). Please, don't put it off. The lives of your love ones may <u>indeed</u> depend on the "<u>choice</u>" you make right now.
