any are "called," but very few are <u>CHO-</u> <u>SEN</u>. If you are a child of God, you have been chosen to be a soldier of Jesus Christ while on this earth. As a soldier, our battles are not against flesh and blood, "...*but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual* <u>wickedness in high places</u>" (EPHES. 6:12) that seek to tempt us through the flesh.

Satan knows that man's fleshly nature is his <u>weak-</u><u>ness</u>. Our salvation depended upon Jesus coming in the "<u>likeness</u>" of our sinful flesh, to condemn sin and set us free from the "bondage" of sin.

So, as "good" soldiers (2 Tim. 2:3), our daily warfare is bringing our bodies under subjection, so that we can remain "profitable" servants to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

The Apostle Paul said, "I have fought a **good fight**, I have **finished my course**, I have **kept the faith**" (2 Tim. 4:7). Our goal is to run "our" race that we may obtain "our" <u>crown of righteous-</u> <u>ness</u>!

Our **<u>FIRST</u>** duty then as a soldier is to **<u>PUT OFF</u>**.

WE ARE TO "...**PUT_OFF** CONCERNING THE FORMER CONVERSATION (BEHAVIOR) THE OLD MAN...AND <u>PUT_ON</u> THE NEW MAN, WHICH AFTER GOD IS CREATED IN RIGHTEOUSNESS AND TRUE HOLINESS" (EPHES, 4:22-24).

WHY? Because

"...OUR OLD MAN IS CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST, THAT <u>THE BODY OF SIN</u> MIGHT BE <u>DE-</u> <u>STROYED</u> (TO RENDER ENTIRELY IDLE), THAT HENCEFORTH WE SHOULD <u>NOT SERVE</u> (OR BE A SLAVE TO) <u>SIN</u>" (ROMANS 6:6). Our duty is to **SUBMIT** ourselves to God...become **OBEDIENT** to His word. We are to **RESIST** the devil, and God has promised in his word...

"...HE WILL FLEE FROM YOU" (JAMES 4:7).

But Satan will be back to tempt us again. He will not give up "because he <u>KNOWETH</u> that he hath but a <u>SHORT</u> time" (REVELATION 12:12).

Paul said, "...*I <u>keep under</u>* (to subdue one's passions) my body, and <u>bring it into subjection</u> (to enslave it): lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a <u>castaway</u> (unapproved; rejected)" (1 COR. 9:27). We should all do the same.

"...BUT **NOW** YE ALSO **PUT OFF ALL** THESE; ANGER (VIOLENT PASSION), WRATH (FIERCENESS), MALICE (ACTIVE ILL WILL), BLASPHEMY (THE USE OF ABUSIVE LAN-**GUAGE), FILTHY COMMUNICATION** (OFFENSIVE TO THE SENSES; REPULSIVE; DIS-GUSTING) OUT OF YOUR MOUTH. LIE NOT (TO UTTER AN UNTRUTH) ONE TO ANOTHER, SEEING THAT YE HAVE PUT OFF (TO STRIP OFF) THE OLD MAN WITH HIS DEEDS (OR PRACTICES); AND HAVE <u>PUT ON</u> (TO SINK INTO A GARMENT) THE NEW MAN, WHICH IS **<u>RENEWED</u>** IN **<u>KNOWLEDGE</u>** (DISCERNMENT) AFTER THE IMAGE OF HIM (GOD) THAT CREATED HIM (THE NEW MAN)" (COL. 3:8-10).

Our **<u>SECOND</u>** duty as a soldier is to **<u>PUT ON</u>**.

We are commanded to **<u>put on</u>** the <u>**WHOLE**</u> armor of God, not just "part" of it. We need a complete <u>**SUIT**</u> of protection...

"...THAT YE MAY BE ABLE TO <u>STAND AGAINST</u> THE WILES (OR **TRICKERY**) OF THE DEVIL" (EPH. 6:11).

PUT ON THE WHOLE ARMOR OF GOD

"WHEREFORE TAKE UNTO YOU THE WHOLE ARMOR OF GOD, THAT YE MAY BE ABLE TO WITHSTAND IN THE EVIL DAY, AND HAV-ING DONE ALL, TO <u>STAND</u>" (Eph. 6:13).

In the last days, "*evil men* and *seducers* shall *wax* (or GROW) worse and worse, deceiving (to cause to roam from truth), and being deceived (to roam from truth)" (2 TIM. 3:13). Also, "they shall *turn away* their *ears* (faith comes by hearing...) from the *TRUTH*, and shall be *turned* unto *fables* (fiction)" (2 TIM. 4:4).

TRUTH There are six items that complete the armor. The first item of armor is the belt that encircles about our loins...called <u>TRUTH</u>: "<u>Stand</u> therefore, having your <u>loins girt about</u> (to fasten one's belt) with <u>TRUTH</u>...

"JESUS SAITH UNTO HIM, I AM THE <u>WAY</u>, <u>THE</u> <u>TRUTH</u>, AND THE <u>LIFE</u>: <u>NO MAN</u> COMETH UNTO THE FATHER, BUT BY ME" (JOHN 14:6).

RIGHTEOUSNESS The second item of armor is called the <u>BREASTPLATE</u>, which during medieval times was to protect the front and the back of the body. "...and having on the <u>breastplate</u> of <u>righteousness</u> (justification=just as if you have never committed a sin)...

"FOR AS BY ONE MAN'S DISOBEDIENCE (ADAM) MANY WERE <u>MADE SINNERS</u>, SO BY THE OBE-DIENCE OF ONE (JESUS CHRIST) SHALL MANY BE <u>MADE RIGHTEOUS</u>" (ROMANS 5:19).

THE GOSPEL OF PEACE The third item of armor is the <u>PREPA-</u> <u>RATION</u> to go into <u>ALL</u> the world and preach the gospel to every creature..."And your feet <u>shod</u> (to put on shoes or sandals) with the <u>preparation</u> (be in readiness) of <u>the gospel of peace</u>...

"AS IT IS WRITTEN, HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE **FEET** OF THEM THAT PREACH **THE GOS- PEL OF PEACE**, AND BRING GLAD TIDINGS OF GOOD THINGS" (ROMANS 10:15)! **FAITH** The fourth item of armor is the <u>SHIELD</u> used for protection from incoming threats. "Above all, <u>taking</u> the <u>SHIELD</u> (a large shield, as door-shaped) of <u>FAITH</u> (persuasion), where with ye shall be able to <u>quench</u> (to extinguish) <u>ALL</u> the fiery darts of the wicked...

"NOW **FAITH** IS THE **SUBSTANCE** OF THINGS <u>HOPED</u> FOR, THE **EVIDENCE** OF THINGS <u>NOT SEEN</u>...BUT <u>WITHOUT FAITH</u> IT IS **IMPOSSIBLE** TO PLEASE GOD: FOR HE THAT COMETH TO GOD <u>MUST</u> BELIEVE THAT HE IS, AND THAT HE IS A REWARDER OF THEM THAT **DILIGENTLY SEEK** HIM" (HEBREWS 11:1,6).

Remember, **EVERY** word of God is **PURE**. God is a **SHIELD**...but **ONLY** unto them that **PUT** their **TRUST** in Him (Read Proverbs 30:5).

SALVATION The fifth item of armor is called the <u>HELMET</u>, used for the protection of the head. *"And take the <u>helmet</u> of <u>salva-</u> <u>tion</u> (defense)...*

> "NEITHER IS THERE SALVATION IN ANY OTHER: FOR THERE IS NONE OTHER NAME UNDER HEAVEN GIVEN AMONG MEN, WHEREBY WE MUST BE SAVED" (ACTS 4:12).

THE SWORD The sixth, and final item of armor is called "...<u>the sword of the</u> <u>Spirit</u>, which is <u>the word of God</u>...

"FOR THE WORD OF GOD IS **QUICK** (TO MAKE ALIVE), AND **POWERFUL** (ACTIVE; ACCOMPLISHING WHAT IS DESIRED), AND SHARPER THAN ANY TWOEDGED SWORD..." (HEBREWS 4:12).

So, in summery, If we have been "<u>called</u>" to be a soldier, then we <u>MUST</u> be prepared to do battle against the flesh. No soldier of Jesus Christ will "...entangeth himself with the affairs of this life; that he (the believer) may please him (God) who hath <u>chosen</u> him (put your name there) to be a soldier" (2 TIMOTHY 2:4).

"Put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof" (ROMANS 13:14).
