The Simplicity that is IN Christ

Paul said, "But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his <u>SUBTILTY</u>, so your minds should be <u>corrupted</u> from the <u>simplicity that is in Christ</u>. For if he that cometh preacheth <u>another</u> Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive <u>another</u> spirit, which ye have not accepted, or <u>another</u> gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him" (2 COR. 11:3-4).

What is the **SIMPLICITY** that is in Christ? The answer to every question is always found in the Word of God.

"The <u>law of the Lord</u> is perfect [ENTIRE], converting the soul: the <u>testimony of the Lord</u> is sure [CERTAIN], making wise the simple. The <u>statutes of the Lord</u> are right [STRAIGHT], rejoicing the heart: the <u>commandment of the Lord</u> is pure [CLEAR], enlightening the eyes. The <u>fear of the Lord</u> is clean, enduring for ever: the <u>judgments of the Lord</u> are true [TRUSTWORTHINESS] and righteous [TO BE RIGHT] altogether" (PSALM 19:7-9).

There is nothing complicated about God's plan of salvation which He alone provided for every man and woman, and every boy and girl. Our very own nature from birth proves that we all need <u>saving</u>:

"...for we have before **PROVED** both Jews and Gentiles, that they are **ALL** under sin; as it is written, There is **NONE** righteous, no, **NOT ONE**: There is **NONE** that understandeth, there is **NONE** that seeketh after God. They are **ALL** gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is **NONE** that doeth good, no, **NOT ONE**. Their **throat** is an open sepulchre; with their **tongues** they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their **lips**: Whose **mouth** is full of cursing and bitterness: Their **feet** are swift to shed blood: Destruction and misery are **in their ways**: And **the way**

of peace have they not known: There is no fear of God before their eyes" (ROMANS 3:9-18).

God knows that "...<u>EVERY</u> man [AND WOMAN] is tempted, when he is <u>drawn away</u> of his <u>own lust</u> [A LONGING FOR WHAT IS FORBIDDEN], and enticed [ENTRAPPED]. Then when <u>lust hath conceived</u>, it <u>bringeth forth sin</u>: and sin, when it is finished, <u>bringeth forth death</u>" (JAMES 1:14-15).

So God sent His only Son into the world to save man from *the penalty of sin* which is **DEATH**. Since disobeying God's word brings forth sin, Jesus, who was obedient to the Father in all things, took our place by suffering *the penalty of sin*, **DYING** upon the cross.



On the third day after his death, God INDEED defeated death by raising Jesus from the dead. And now, God commands all the world to <u>repent</u>, "Because he hath <u>appointed a day</u>, in the which he will <u>judge</u> the world in righteousness by that <u>man</u> [KNOWN AS "THE WORD OF GOD"] whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath <u>GIVEN ASSURANCE</u> unto <u>ALL</u> men, in that he hath <u>raised him from the</u> dead" (ACTS 17:30-31).

The simplicity of the gospel (<u>or the good news</u>) of Christ is very evident: "...how that <u>Christ died</u> for our sins according to the scriptures; And that <u>he was buried</u>, and that <u>he rose again the third day</u> according to the scriptures" (1 Cor. 15:1-4).

What we must do before we die is also very clear: "...if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved (ROMANS 10:9-10). God cannot lie! Believe Him now.
