hen Iranian president, Mahmoud Ahmadinejad, said to thousands of students in a 2005 speech, "Israel <u>must</u> be wiped off the map," he officially set himself, his people, and those who agree with him, <u>against</u> God.

The name "Israel" appears in the scriptures 2294 times, and is mentioned last in the book of Revelation concerning the "New Jerusalem" coming down from Heaven with names written on twelve gates:

"And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of <u>Israel</u>" (REV. 21:10-12).

No, the nation Israel will <u>never</u> be "<u>wiped off</u>" the map by any nation because Israel belongs to Jehovah God who said, "*I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee*" (GENESIS 12:3).

Islam is a unique <u>false</u> religion because it seeks to supplant both <u>Judaism</u> and <u>Christianity</u> with its own version of "<u>truth</u>" written in their Qur'an by a man name Muhammad. It's followers believe that Abraham was commanded by God to sacrifice his son **ISHMAEL**, instead of **ISAAC**, which puts them at odds with the Jews.

But when God spoke to Moses at the burning bush, God introduced Himself: "I am the God of thy father,

the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob" (Exodus 3:6). Even the Apostle Paul wrote to the believers in Galatia, "Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise" (GALATIANS 4:28).

God warns those of us who are born of the Spirit: "Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time" (1 JOHN 2:18). The word "antichrist" means "an opponent of the Messiah."





Islam has a foothold in many nations, mingling with the population and gaining converts, teaching their doctrine wherever possible.

The book of Revelation is a book that "<u>reveals</u>" to the believer of what is to come: "...Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand" (REV. 22:10). The one who penned down these words, also wrote these:

"Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son" (1 JOHN 2:22). "...every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world" (1 JOHN 4:3).

There is nothing "peaceful" about any religion that reduces the Son of God to just a prophet. Islam's objective is very clear, and they are bold enough to tell you: "Islam will dominate the world." Jesus said: "what I say unto you I say unto all, Watch" (MARK 13:37).
