

## **Salvation's Simplicity**

There are many "<u>religious faiths</u>" in the world today, but the simple <u>road to salvation</u> begins with Hebrews 11, verses 1 and 6: "Now FAITH is the SUBSTANCE of things hoped for, the EVIDENCE of things not seen"..."But WITHOUT FAITH it is IMPOSSIBLE to please him (God): for he that COMETH to God MUST believe that HE IS, and that he is a REWARDER of them that DILIGENTLY SEEK HIM (God)."



Understanding what <u>faith</u> means is not difficult. As children, we believed <u>every word</u> our parents said (<u>faith</u>), even though we did not <u>fully</u> understand them. But, <u>gradually</u>, as we <u>grew</u> in "<u>our own knowledge</u>" of things, we began to <u>challenge</u> our parent's authority, and <u>substituted</u> their instruction for our own "<u>understanding</u>." As a result, too many of us are <u>eating</u> of the "...<u>fruit of [our] own [stubborn] way, and [are] filled with [our] own devices</u>" (Proverbs 1:31).

But through faith, "...**we understand** that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things **which are seen** were not made of things **which do appear**" (Hebrews 11:3). We believe that God has <u>always been</u>, and that there was <u>never a time</u> when God <u>was not</u>, "...from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God" (Psalm 90:2).

We do not <u>understand</u> it on a physical scale, but by <u>becoming</u> as <u>little children</u>, we believe it, "...Except (unless) ye be converted, and become as **LITTLE CHILDREN**, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:3).



My journey to salvation began when I met a certain girl, and we engaged ourselves in conversation. To our pleasure, we discovered that we both <u>believed in God</u>. Later, after we decided to marry, we pledged that we would <u>live for God</u>. A year later, discovering that we would become parents, we decided <u>to raise our children for God</u>.

One day, on my way to work, I was listening to my car radio when suddenly I heard a man read these words: "But the fearful, and

unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and **ALL LIARS**, shall have their part in the **LAKE** which **BURNETH** with fire and brimstone: which is the second death" (Rev. 21:8). The only <u>wrong-doing</u> I admitted doing at that time was "**LYING**," because I did it for sport, and was afraid of being "<u>caught</u>" in my lies.

When I **HEARD** these <u>precious</u> words, I felt tremendous personal "**GUILT**," and suddenly, I realized that I was also "<u>guilty</u>" of many other things as well. But after **HEARING** these words: "That if thou shalt **CONFESS** with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt **BELIEVE** in thine heart that God hath **raised him from the dead**, thou shalt be **SAVED**. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation" (Romans 10:9-10), I <u>bowed my head</u> on my steering wheel in the parking lot of my job and confessed to

God in prayer: "God, I'm sorry. Please save me."

At that very moment, the Holy Spirit **BAPTIZED** me into the **BODY** of Jesus Christ, "For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body" (1 Cor. 12:13), **SEALED** me until the day of my redemption, "...whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption" (Ephes. 4:30), and **ADDED** me to the **INVISIBLE** church of the living God, "...And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved" (Acts 2:47).

The Holy Spirit also **ENTERED** me as <u>promised</u> to all believers, <u>making me</u> His **PERMANENT DWELLING PLACE**, "What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own" (1 Cor. 6:19)?

Daily, the Holy Spirit **LEADS ME**, **GUIDES ME**, **COMFORTS ME** and **TEACHES** me **ALL TRUTH**, "...when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come" (John 16:13).



When I walked from the parking lot to my job that day, a **NEW** man entered in, whereas <u>the old man</u> was gone, "...if any man be **IN** Christ, he is a **NEW CREATURE**: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new" (2 Cor. 5:17).

A year later, after observing the change that took place in me, and also my **THIRST** for the Word of God, my wife <u>re-examined</u> herself, <u>repented</u> to God, and God <u>saved</u> her too.

Tragically, there are **BILLIONS** and **BILLIONS** of people who are just <u>a breath away from</u> <u>death</u>, and dropping into **Hell Fire** because they have rejected the **SIMPLICITY** found in God's plan of Salvation.

Too many people are <u>putting their trust</u> in a MAN or a WOMAN, or in some RELIGIOUS WAY; they will even <u>put their trust</u> in some EXPERIENCE like a dream, a vision, or some form of FEELING or their GOOD WORKS.




But Jesus said, "... This is the WORK of God, that ye BELIEVE ON HIM whom he [God] hath sent" (John 6:29). Sadly, Jesus also said, "... ye WILL NOT COME TO ME, that ye might have life" (John 5:40). All God wants US to DO is just COME...

"COME unto me, all ye that <u>labour</u> and are <u>heavy laden</u>, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). "...If any man <u>thirst</u>, let him COME unto me, and drink" (John 7:37). "...the Spirit and the Bride say, COME. And let him that HEARETH say, COME. And let him that is <u>athirst</u> COME. And WHOSOEVER will, let him TAKE the water of life FREELY" (Rev. 22:17).

Jesus said, "I RECEIVE NOT honor from men" (John 5: 41), but the HONOR OF MEN is what the <u>majority</u> of people FOLLOW today, someone they can <u>see</u> and <u>admire</u>, especially those of HIGH RELIGIOUS REPUTATION.

Jesus said, "I am come in my FATHER'S name, and ye RECEIVE ME NOT: if another shall come IN HIS OWN NAME, him YE WILL RECEIVE" (John 5:43), and <u>religious giants</u> are being "<u>well-received</u>" by the thousands.



But the **JUDGMENT** of God will **DECLARE** the **TRUTH** concerning all things. At the Great White Throne Judgment, all <u>false preachers</u> and teachers, along with their <u>entire</u> **CONGREGATION** of **FOLLOWERS** which they have led astray will <u>stand</u> before a **HOLY GOD** and <u>give an account</u>.

The prophet Joel describes this day as a day of a <u>singular</u> decision: "**Multitudes**, **multitudes** in **the valley of decision**: for the day of the Lord is near in the valley of decision" (Joel 3:14).

They will HEAR HIM SAY, "These things hast thou DONE, and I KEPT SILENCE; thou THOUGHTEST THAT I WAS ALTOGETHER SUCH AN ONE AS THEYSELF: but I will REPROVE thee, and SET THEM IN ORDER before THINE EYES" (Psalm 50:21).

In God's plan of Salvation, **ALL** men and women become "...the **SHEEP** of **HIS** pasture" (Psalm 100:3) the same **IDENTICAL WAY**, by becoming as a <u>little child</u> before Him by **FAITH** through the <u>genuine</u> admission of guilt. Jesus said, "Whosoever therefore shall **HUMBLE HIMSELF** as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:4).

Have you <u>humbled</u> yourself before God Almighty, and <u>admitted to Him</u> your <u>guilt</u> as a sinner? The husband of wicked Queen Jezebel, King Ahab, <u>did</u>: "Seest thou how Ahab **HUMBLETH HIMSELF** before me? because he humbleth himself before me, I will not bring the evil in his days: but in his son's days will I bring the evil upon his house" (1 Kings 21:29).



As a servant of God, it is my duty and desire to preach Christ for the purpose of "...warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom" (Col. 1:28). "Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we PERSUADE men" (2 Cor. 5:11).

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that ENTERETH NOT by the DOOR into the sheepfold, but CLIMBETH UP SOME OTHER WAY, the same is a THIEF and a ROBBER" (John 10:1).

Hebrews 11:6 sums up <u>the plan of salvation</u> that we "...**MUST BELIEVE** that **HE** (**God**) **IS**, and that he (**God**) is a **REWARDER** of them that **DILIGENTLY SEEK HIM** (**God**)." Have <u>YOU</u> diligently sought God? Are <u>YOU</u>, or have you ever been **THRISTY** for His truth?

<u>Seeking</u> God means to <u>thoroughly seek Him out</u>; to <u>thoroughly do a full investigation</u>. If the scribes, Pharisees and the Jewish people had <u>diligently investigated</u> Jesus, they would not have crucified him.

A woman in Jesus' parable <u>diligently searched</u> for her lost piece of silver (Luke 15:8), and she found it after <u>lighting a candle</u> (the Word of God) and <u>sweeping the house</u> (doing a thorough search). In the end, she **REJOICED**.

"Let us hear THE CONCLUSION OF THE WHOLE MATTER: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is THE WHOLE DUTY OF MAN" (Eccles. 12:13).

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
