

AS the TORTOISE & the HARE, so also the WHEAT & the TARE

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he story from *Aesop's Fables The Tortoise and the Hare* is about a hare (*rabbit*) who ridicules a slow moving tortoise (*turtle*) and is challenged by him to a race.

The hare soon leaves the tortoise behind and, being CONFIDENT of winning, decides to take a nap midway through the course. In other words, he goes to SLEEP.



When he **AWAKES**, he finds that his competitor, *crawling slowly* but *steadily*, has crossed the finish line before him.

There is a <u>similarity</u> in this story told in the Word of God between <u>true</u> Christians and <u>false</u> Christians, between the **WHEAT** and the **TARES**.

While those who are <u>born of the Spirit</u> suffer persecution, rejected of men and separated from family and friends, those of "<u>religious reputation</u>" are well spoken of and received, flattered, and held in high esteem.



In a certain parable, Jesus said, "...The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in HIS field: but while MEN slept, HIS ENEMY came and sowed TARES AMONG THE WHEAT, and went his way.

The *good seed* and the *wheat* are members of the *true* Church of God who are *born of the Spirit*. The *man* that sowed them is *the Son of God*. His *field* is the world we live in and his *enemy* is the *devil*. The *tares* are the *counterfeit* Church of the devil, that have not been

<u>born again</u>, nor have the <u>Spirit of God</u> dwelling in them.

"But when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then APPEARED THE TARES also.

"So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow GOOD SEED in THY field? From whence then hath it TARES? He said unto them, An ENEMY hath done this.

"The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up? But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the TARES, ye root up also the WHEAT with them.

"LET BOTH GROW TOGETHER until the harvest: and in THE TIME OF HARVEST I will say to the reapers [THE ANGELS], Gather ye together first the TARES, and BIND THEM in bundles to burn them: but gather the WHEAT into MY barn" (MATTHEW 13:24-30).

What is a **TARE**? A *tare* is a **WEED** that commonly grows among wheat. It takes someone *knowledgeable* to identify it.

There are **TWO** types of <u>Christians</u> in the world today, the **WHEAT** and the **TARES**. How can you tell the difference? "...by their **FRUITS** ye shall know them" (MATTHEW 7:20), **BUT** "...The Lord knoweth them that are his" (2 TIM. 2:19).

As the <u>hare</u> was so **CONFIDENT** in his abilities that he <u>took a nap</u>, so **TARES** are so <u>confident</u> in their own <u>goodness</u> and <u>religious upbringing</u>, that they have **IGNORED** God's <u>admonition</u> to:

"...GIVE DILIGENCE to make your calling and election SURE" (2 PETER 1:10), and to "EXAMINE YOURSELVES, whether ye be IN THE FAITH; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is IN YOU" (2 COR. 13:5)?

Is <u>Christ</u> **IN YOU**? Is He, in the person of the Holy Ghost, leading and guiding you into **ALL** truth?

If He is, then, "...ye **NEED NOT** that any man teach you...the same **ANOINTING** teacheth you of **ALL** things, and is truth, and is no



lie" (1 JOHN 2:27). All <u>children of God</u> have this **ANOINTING** from their birth. Do **YOU KNOW** that **YOU** "...are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in **YOU**" (1 COR. 3:16)?

As the <u>poor tortoise</u> was <u>ridiculed</u> by the <u>hare</u>, so "the **WICKED** in his **PRIDE** doth **PERSECUTE** the **POOR** [THE HUMBLE]" (PSALM 10:2). But, "...the **MEEK** [THE HUMBLE] shall inherit the earth" (PSALM 37:11), just as the <u>tortoise</u>, through <u>patience</u>, won the race.

In this world, **TARES** make a religious show, drawing attention to **THEMSELVES** instead of Christ, and are glorified <u>of men</u>. Jesus said, "they **HAVE** their reward" (MATTHEW 6:2, 5, 16) **RIGHT NOW**.

Yet, the WHEAT are told that they will SUFFER for His name's sake. Count it all joy, "...when men shall HATE you, and when they shall SEPARATE you from their company, and shall REPROACH you, and CAST OUT your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake" (LUKE 6:22).

True children of God are told to "REJOICE, and be EXCEEDING GLAD: for GREAT is your REWARD in heaven" (MATTHEW 5:11-12). We are "...SOWN in WEAKNESS" but "...RAISED IN POWER" (1 COR. 15:43) because God said "...my STRENGTH is MADE PERFECT in WEAKNESS" (2 COR. 12:9).

We are living in the <u>time</u> of the <u>twelfth hour</u>, just before the return of the bridegroom, Christ Jesus, who will gather all <u>true</u> believers to Himself (MATT. 25).

Are you <u>trusting</u> in your <u>good works</u>, or your <u>good intentions</u>? "...**THEY** that were **READY** went in with him to the marriage" (MATTHEW 25:10). Are you **READY**? Are you **SURE**? If not, then **REPENT**.
